Together they explored the Alberta Nutrition Guidelines For Children and Youth and shared valuable resources to promote better nutrition in the school community. It's all part of the school's dedication to nurturing a healthy and vibrant learning environment.

**St. Benedict Catholic Elementary School**, part of the [Edmonton Catholic School Division](#), prioritizes promoting healthy lifestyles among its students. Their commitment is reflected in their action plan, which includes goals aimed at reducing fast-food consumption and encouraging nutritious food choices.

In a heartwarming gesture, the school dedicated a recent chilly winter day to make bannock, extending a warm welcome to their newest teacher. This initiative not only embraced the new staff member but also provided a great opportunity to learn a new skill.





**Douglas Harkness School**, part of the [Calgary Board of Education](#), is embracing its new status as an APPLE School by promoting increased water intake among students and staff. They initiated a staff-focused water challenge, offering APPLE cups and enticing incentives like an additional prep period and exclusive use of the principal's parking spot for a month to the winner!

They have also introduced a "Spa Water" hydration station for students, featuring weekly rotating fruit-infused water blends such as pineapple, passion fruit, star fruit, and blueberry, which has proven immensely popular as the students get very creative trying new recipes. Recognizing the success and sustainability of this initiative, the school has decided to invest in reusable water bottles for its students, reducing the need for disposable cups.
